The Liard River is underlain by soft shale-rich rocks... The famous Liard River Hot Springs are one of the most visited sites on the Alaska Highway.

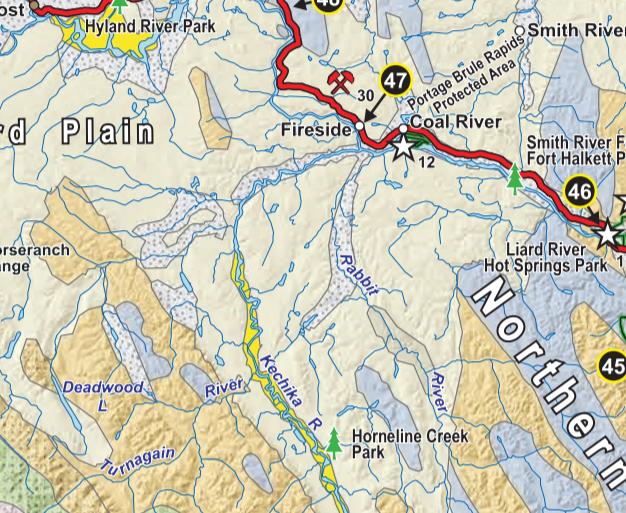
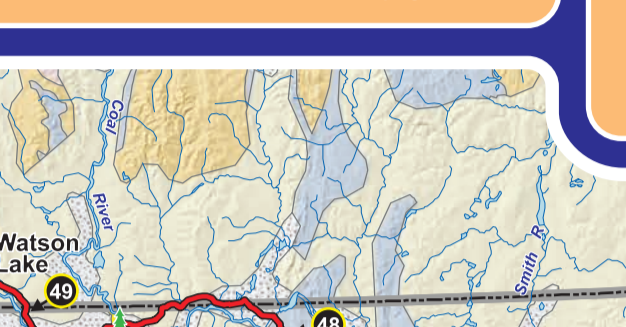
