

MineralsEd: Stanley Park GeoTour

Teacher Pro-D Field Trip, October 23, 2020

A look beyond the trees....

The trees in Stanley Park may be hundreds of years old, but the park's history started long before then.

Join MineralsEd and **Dr. Brian McNulty** for a walk through beautiful Stanley Park, Vancouver, to explore the geological history and formations of the Stanley Park area.

During this 3-hour guided tour participants will:

- examine the composition, texture, and structure of the rocks along the seawall and shoreline,
- look for evidence of rock-forming processes, surface processes, and glaciation in the area,
- reconstruct the geological history of the area and how it relates to the overall geology of BC, and
- discuss the connections between the geology of the area and later human activity.

This interactive field trip will benefit teachers at all grade levels who teach units in Earth Science or geology, mineral resources, and mining. This workshop is intended to provide teachers with the resources and know-how to conduct their own in-person or virtual Stanley Park GeoTour with their own classes.
